

和合石行人和單車天橋上單車徑的臨時交通措施通知

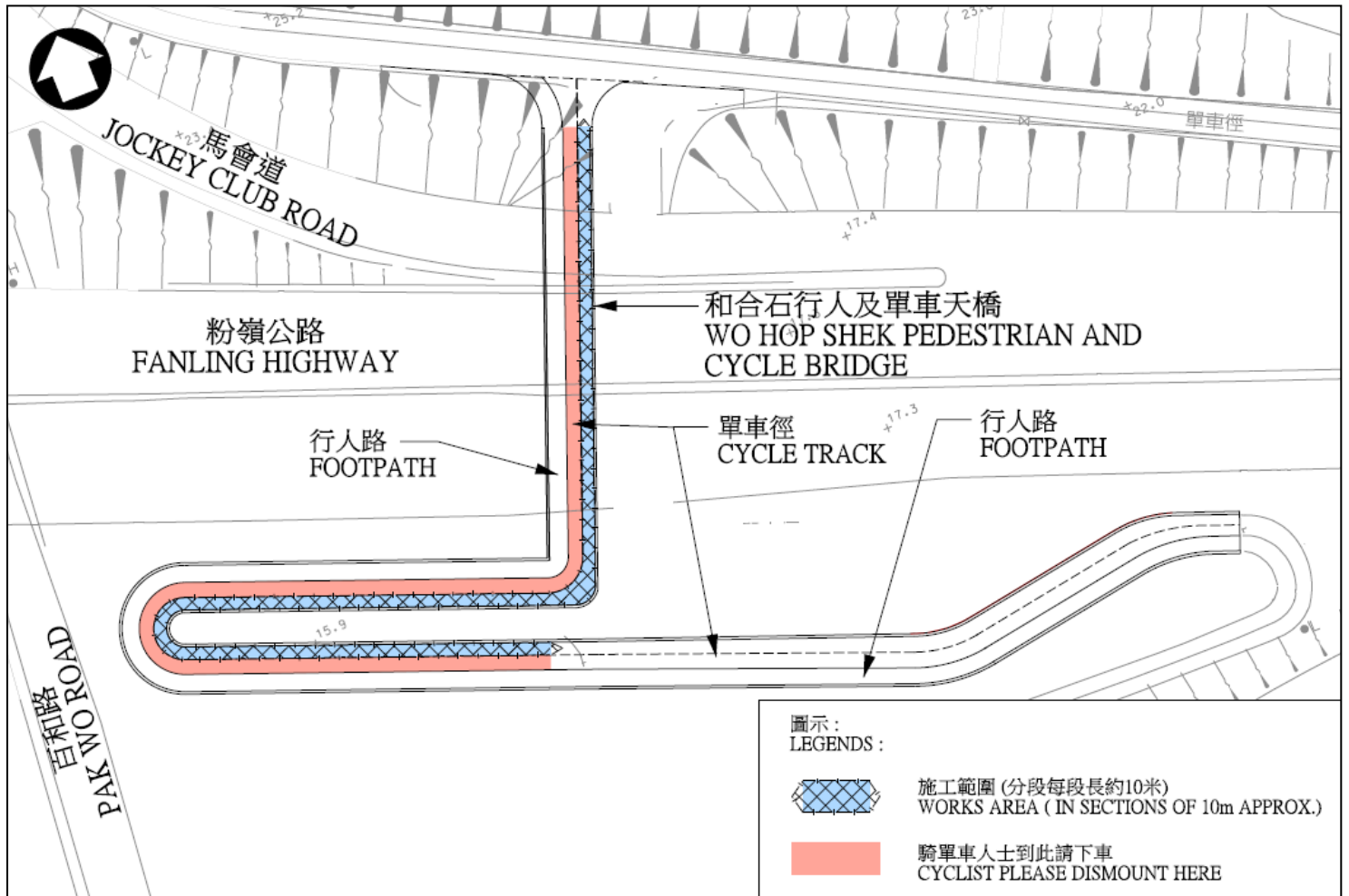
Notification of Temporary Traffic Arrangement of Cycle Track on Wo Hop Shek Pedestrian & Cycle Bridge

為進行和合石行人和單車天橋的欄杆工程，該天橋將會於 2018 年 11 月中旬至 2019 年 1 月中旬分階段實施臨時交通安排。工程進行期間，將分段圍封部分單車徑(每段長度約 10 米)。

現場會設置適當的臨時交通標誌指示各道路使用者，騎單車人士在途經受影響路段時須依照臨時交通標誌的指示下車。我們為此工程將造成的不便之處，謹此致歉。

To facilitate the railing works of Wo Hop Shek Pedestrian & Cycle Bridge, temporary traffic arrangement will be implemented from mid-November 2018 to mid-January 2019. The cycle track will be temporarily fenced off in stages (approximately 10m long) for carrying out the construction works.

Appropriate temporary traffic signs will be provided on site to guide road users. Cyclists are required to dismount in accordance with the temporary traffic signs when passing through this section of cycle track. We are sorry for any inconvenience caused due to the construction works.



駐工地工程人員於施工期間會進行定期檢查及監督承建商的工作。在安全及切實可行的情況下，盡量減少需要封閉或收窄單車徑的範圍及縮短臨時交通安排的實施時間。此外，我們會與單車團體緊密溝通及聯絡，以減低對道路使用者的不便。

Resident Site Staff will carry out regular inspections and closely supervise the Contractor's works. The works will be carried out with minimal extent and shortest duration of closure or narrowing of the cycle track as far as practicable and in a safe manner. In addition, we will closely liaise and communicate with cycling associations so as to minimize the inconvenience to the road users.
