

和合石行人和單車天橋上單車徑的臨時交通措施通知

Notification of Temporary Traffic Arrangement of Cycle Track on Wo Hop Shek Pedestrian & Cycle Bridge

為建造行人路、單車徑、護土牆及排水系統，連接和合石行人和單車天橋出入口及附近一段現有行人路及單車徑，將於 2019 年 10 月 16 日至 2020 年 1 月分階段實施臨時封閉措施（詳情請參閱圖示一及二）。上述工程進行期間，現場將提供寬度最少為兩米的臨時通道，騎單車人士途經該路段時，請依照現場指示及標誌下車，以確保騎單車人士及行人安全。我們謹為此工程造成的不便之處致歉。

有關臨時封路詳情如下：

2019 年 10 月 16 日至 2020 年 1 月

To facilitate the construction of footpath, cycle track, retaining wall and drainage system at the tie in between Wo Hop Shek Pedestrian & Cycle Bridge and existing cycle track, temporary traffic arrangement will be implemented from 16 October 2019 to January 2020. The cycle track will be temporarily fenced off in two stages (Please refer to Figure no.1 & 2 for details) for carrying out the construction works. During this period, the passage will be maintained at a width not less than 2m.

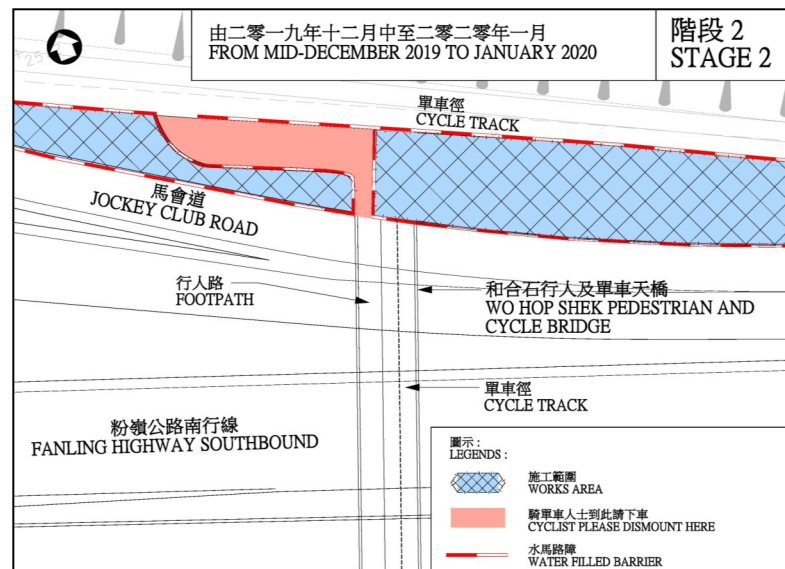
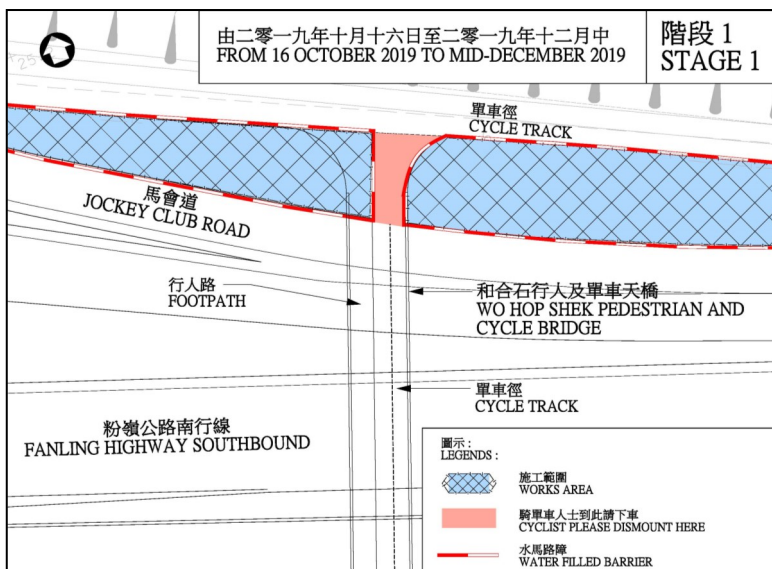
To ensure the safety of cyclists and pedestrians, cyclists are reminded to follow the instructions of temporary traffic signs erected on site when they are passing through the aforesaid area.

駐工地工程人員於施工期間會進行定期檢查及監督承建商的工作。在安全及切實可行的情況下，盡量減少需要封閉或收窄單車徑的範圍及縮短臨時交通安排的實施時間。此外，我們會與單車團體緊密溝通及聯絡，以減低對道路使用者的不便。

The works will be carried out with minimal extent and shortest duration of closure or narrowing of the cycle track as far as practicable and in a safe manner. In addition, we will closely liaise and communicate with cycling associations so as to minimize the inconvenience to the road users.
